Instructions:

1. The Nomination can be made by individuals only applying/holding shares/debentures/bonds on their own behalf singly or jointly. Non-individual including society, trust, body corporate, partnership firm, Karta of Hindu Undivided Family, holder of power of attorney cannot nominate. If the shares are held jointly, all joint holders will sign the nomination form. Space is provided as a specimen, if there are more joint holders more sheets can be added for signatures of holders of shares/holders and witness.
2. A Minor can be nominated by a holder of shares/debentures/deposits/bonds and in that event the name and address of the Guardian shall be given by the holder.
3. The nominee shall not be trust, society, body corporate, partnership firm, Karta of Undivided Family or a power of attorney holder. A non-resident Indian can be a nominee on re-patriable basis.
4. Nomination stand rescinded upon transfer of share/debenture or repayment/renewal of deposits made.
5. Transfer of share/debenture in favour of a nominee and repayment of amount of deposit to nominee shall be a valid discharge by a company against the legal heir.
